

EXAMPLE: Team Fees & Due Dates for 2026

Tuition is due on the 1st of each month.

Bill Creation Date	the 20th of each month, for the following month
Late Fee Assessment (\$10)	COB the 1st of the current month, if the monthly tuition has not been paid
Automatic Charge to Checking Acct/Card on File (addl \$35 fee if declined or if payment method on file is invalid)	the 5th of the current month, if the monthly tuition has not been paid

Note: You may pay any portion of these fees early or in a lump sum, but a minimum of the amount listed here **MUST** be paid by the date shown. You may also opt to sign up for a Payment Plan that spreads these fees (excl. USAG Annual Membership Fee) and Jan-Aug tuition equally over the first 8 months of 2026 (\$371-\$484/month for 8 months). Tuition for Sep-Dec will still be due on the 1st of each month.

**Fees are subject to change. These prices are based on 2025 costs.*

- Parents/Guardians are responsible for paying USA Gymnastics directly for their gymnast's annual membership (approximately \$75). This is due by July 31, 2026. Your USA Gymnastics membership must be renewed every year.
- USA Gymnastics will not allow your gymnast to compete, register for or attend any USAG sanctioned events until this fee is settled, and **you will not receive a refund for meets not attended.**
- The Spring Recital will be May 15-17, and the Team Camp for will be in June, exact week is TBA.
- Recitals, Clinics and Team Camps are mandatory for team gymnasts to build choreography skills and team morale. All meets are mandatory for team gymnasts.

If they demonstrate the appropriate skills and attitude, new gymnasts trying out will be placed in XCel Bronze, Level 1, Level 2, Level 3 or XCel Silver. In order to advance to higher levels within their program in future seasons, gymnasts must: 1) Master the appropriate skills to allow them to progress to the skills in the next level, 2) Show the proper attitude and mental readiness for the demands of the next level, 3) Maintain strength and conditioning standards in place to ensure all athletes are able to safely perform their skills, and 4) Attain the minimum scores required by both USA Gymnastics & Ingrid's Birmingham Elite Gymnastics in competition.

Compulsory Program (Levels 1-5): The Compulsory Program consists of specific routines that the gymnast must learn exactly as they are written. USA Gymnastics created these routines with the goal that the gymnasts learn discipline and have a strong gymnastics foundation before advancing to the Optionals levels. All of the skills in compulsory gymnastics are progressive.

XCel Program (Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum, Diamond): The Xcel Program is an alternative USA Gymnastics competitive program offering individual flexibility to coaches and gymnasts. The goal of XCel is to provide gymnasts of varying abilities and commitment levels the opportunity for a rewarding gymnastics experience.

Optionals Program (Levels 6-10): The Optionals Program has a set of guidelines, or level requirements, and routines are built around them. Each gymnast has her own music and choreography. Her routine is built to show off her strengths.

Some points included in the
Ingrid's Birmingham Elite Gymnastics Team
Payment Contract

- * I understand I must keep a valid payment method on file in my account at all times while my gymnast is a part of the Ingrid's Birmingham Elite Gymnastics team program.
- * I understand that I must give 30-day written notice to withdraw my child from the Ingrid's Birmingham Elite Gymnastics team program, and I understand that I will be billed for all items or events scheduled to be paid in the next 30 days, regardless of whether or not my child is able to participate.
- * I understand that as a member of the team, I am committing to pay for each of the scheduled meets in the 2026 season, even if my gymnast does not attend, and I understand I will not receive a refund for meets not attended.
- * Should I fall behind or fail to make payments, I recognize that my gymnast's involvement with Ingrid's Birmingham Elite Gymnastics team program will be jeopardized.
- * I also understand that if my gymnast quits or is released from Ingrid's Birmingham Elite Gymnastics team, at any point throughout the season, I will still be financially responsible for fees already incurred.
- * I understand that if I fail to make any of my payments by their due date, a late fee will be assessed and the payment method on file will be charged for the amount due plus the late fee.

Competitive gymnastics is a huge commitment for the gymnast, her family and her coaches, so please be sure this is something that you and your gymnast both want and can afford before committing.

You may withdraw your gymnast from the competitive team at any time, but you are still responsible for any tuition or fees due within the following 30 days, regardless of whether or not your gymnast is participating.
